Current events, prices and more

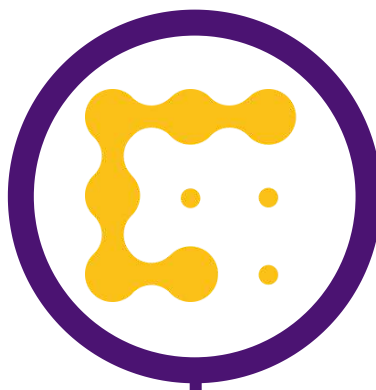
